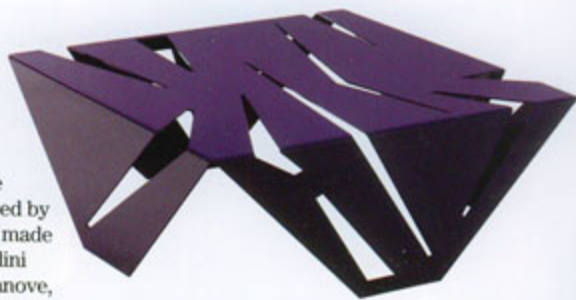

The formal purity of the new Special Collection Blue by IVV Home is enhanced by the brilliance of the glass enhanced by a high-impact optical texture made entirely by hand. LEM by Bedini Raco Settimelli, from Officinanove, is an ingenious table in aluminium, with elegant and odd laser cuts.



Polished reflection A contemporary interpretation from Vervly, in wood, steel and hand-worked two-way mirror, its frame is covered with mirror-polished steel on four sides and double-glass square in extra-light glass, a wooden top and bottom with scaled sides finished in black nitro-polish.
